Use-case: Securing Online Banking Accounts with Minimal Tech Knowledge

Protecting your bank account with simple steps

- 1 Install a password manager like Bitwarden and generate unique 16+ character passwords.
- 2 Stop saving banking passwords in your browser; use your password manager instead.
- 3 Enable app-based two-factor authentication (Google Authenticator) on your bank account today.
- 4 Delete unnecessary apps from your phone and only download from official app stores.
- 5 Install mobile security software like Malwarebytes Mobile (\$12/year) on your smartphone.
- 6 Never access your bank account on public Wi-Fi without a VPN connection.
- 7 Update your bank account recovery email and phone number in account settings.
- 8 Store your password manager master password and recovery codes on paper securely.
- 9 Ask your bank to offer app-based 2FA if SMS is currently the only option.
- 10 Review your bank's backup recovery options and add a trusted contact if available.
- 11 Stop using SMS two-factor authentication and switch to authenticator apps immediately.
